

# BLEACH LB92

## Liquid chlorine sanitiser and bleach

**BLEACH LB92** removes stubborn stains, disinfects and deodorises. In the laundry it will whiten and brighten colour fast fabrics and disinfest the wash load. It can be used to disinfect hard surfaces. It will deodorise drains and urinals. It will remove mould in bathrooms and moss and lichen from tiled roofs.

### CHEMICAL AND PHYSICAL PROPERTIES

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

#### Laundry:

**Machine washing.** Load and start the machine. Dilute 100 ml of bleach with 1 litre of water and add the diluted bleac at the end of the end of the fill cycle.

**Hand washing.** Dilute 50 ml of bleach with 5 Lt of water and mix well before adding the clothes.

Nappies. Clean the nappies. Soak in a mixture of 50 ml of bleach and 5 Lt of water for 10 minutes. Rinse well.

**Stain removal.** Dilute 100 ml of bleach with 4 Lt of cold water. Soak the clothes for 10 minutes.

**Colourfast test.** Most modern fabrics are colourfast. To test mix 1 part of bleach with 2 parts of water. Test 1 drop of this mix on an inconspicuous part of the garment. Make sure the drop penetrates, let stan for 2 minutes and blot dry.

#### Hard Surfaces: (such as tables and floors, kitchens, bathroom, dustbins, concrete, roofing)

Mix 50 ml of bleach to 1 Lt of water. Apply to the surface, leave for 5 minutes and rinse off.

#### **Toilets:**

Pour 100 ml into the toilet bowl and clean with a brush. Leave for 10 minutes and then flush. It is safe for septic systems. Clean and disinfect the toilet seat with 50 ml of bleach to 1 Lt of water. Leave for 5 minutes. Rinse or wipe off with a dry cloth.

#### **Rooping:**

Mix 50 ml of bleach with 1 Lt of water to remove lichen amnd mould.
